Welcome to Foods II! This class is designed to allow students to learn and practice a variety of cooking skills, as well as explore different foods from around the world.

Curriculum:

- Food/Kitchen Safety
- Kitchen Tools & Equipment
- Measuring & Abbreviations
- Recipe Reading/Cooking Terms
- A "Cultural Foods Project" focusing on a specific culture and its food. Students will have the opportunity to demonstrate a food relating to their selected culture.

Materials:

Students will need a spiral notebook in which to keep notes, recipes, vocabulary information, and other worksheets. Walker Middle School will provide all of the items and ingredients necessary for the cooking labs.

Grades:

Student grades are based on a combination of hands-on projects, labs, written work, and tests. The grading scale for this class is:

A	=	90%-100%
B	=	80% - 89%
C	=	70% - 79%
D	=	60% - 69%
F	=	0% - 59%

Behavior Expectations:

Students are expected to behave according to class rules.

- O - Student is always on task, and works cooperatively in the kitchen group
- S - Student is consistently on task and works cooperatively in the kitchen group with only occasional reminders
- N - Student is often off task, sometimes behaves inappropriately or disrespectfully to others
- U - Student is usually off task and often behaves inappropriately or disrespectfully to others

Work Habits:

Students are expected to complete all assignments and actively participate in labs.

- O - Completes all assignments, keeps notebook current, takes leadership role in labs
- S - Completes all assignments, keeps notebook current, participates in labs
- N - Completes some assignments, notebook has assignments missing, inconsistent participation in labs
- U - Few assignments completed, notebook is incomplete, does not participate in labs

Tag Modifications:

- Group learning
- Modified projects
- Enhanced reading/math
- Enrichment options
